



## Audrey Carmichael

January 14, 1931 - September 22, 2024

Audrey Carmichael, 93, passed away peacefully at home on the morning of September 22, 2024, surrounded by her loving family after a courageous battle with a recurring illness.

She was born in Saskatchewan, Canada, in 1931; Audrey was the youngest of seven siblings. She often reminisced about the lively and humorous adventures of growing up on the prairie.
