She was active in the Calvary Chapel in Cle Elum and the Kittitas County Military Vehicle Group. Barb was at peace with her fate. She would be joining her high school sweetheart and loving husband of 49 years, Bruce Muzzey, in Heaven.

Barb was kind and talented. She sewed many projects including all three of her daughter's wedding dresses and thousands of face masks for various communities during the pandemic. She loved to cook and was often called "hot pad hands" by her children because she touched hot things with her bare hands. Barb also enjoyed painting. She would paint anything that had a surface like car tire flower beds, rocks and broken concrete chunks.

Barbara is survived by her sister Connie, children Becky, Beth, Bree, and Ben, and many grandchildren.

A Celebration of Life will be held at Calvary Chapel in Cle Elum on Saturday September 9, 2023 at 2:00pm. Immediately following services both Barbara and Bruce's ashes will take a final army truck ride together to Sky Meadows

Ranch for further celebration. Pie will be served at their cabin as well as rocks and paints available to anyone to paint and leave in their yard somewhere.

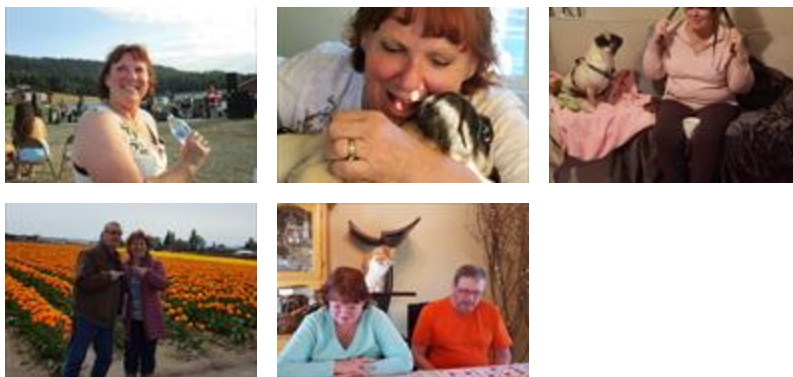

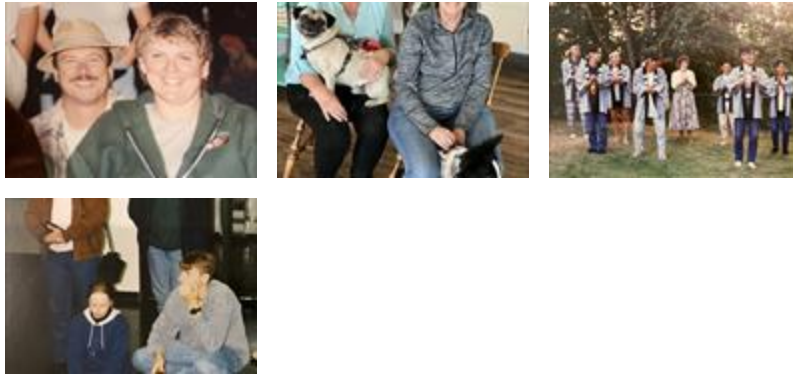

*Monica and I are sad to have to share the passing of a dear friend, Barb Muzzey, who has been a resident of Sky Meadows Ranch for several years.*

*Barb volunteered for our community on the Bunkhouse Committee and handled the phone reservations for Members and guests. She sewed curtains for the Lodge and Bunkhouse, changed sheets, did laundry and opened the buildings as guests would arrive. Barb also served as our Association Clerk, checking the mail, scanning documents and making deposits at the bank in town.*

*Barb's husband, Bruce, was the Water Trustee for several years before he passed away of cancer three years ago. Now Barb will again be with Bruce- who we know she missed every day.*

*At the end of July, Barb suddenly started not feeling well and was having trouble keeping food down. Her daughter took Barb to the ER where they discovered blood clots in her lungs, unfortunately caused by stage-4 pancreatic cancer.*

*Monica and I had the chance to visit Barb last Thursday in the hospital in Wenatchee before being sent home to Becky's house on hospice. The cancer had gone too far. Barb was obviously uncomfortable, but she never complained.*

*Barb had accepted what God had intended for her and just wanted to be surrounded by family, friends and laughter. After tears, hugs and loves exchanged, we promised to visit Barb again yesterday.*

*But Barb passed away peacefully on Saturday night, surrounded by her children and grandchildren. She even waited until her older sister could arrive to say goodbye, before Barb went off to again to be with Bruce.*

*As we drive by Barb's house up and down the hill, we still want to honk "beep beep" with her texting back each time "beep beep". Or to stop in to say hello and give Winston some scratching. We still can see Barb out walking Winston by the dumpster. It is hard to understand how someone could be gone so quickly from our lives...*
