



## Betty Jean Schillereff

September 7, 1923 - June 2, 2017

Betty Jean Schillereff, age 93, a long-time resident of Wenatchee, WA, died Friday morning, June 2, 2017, at Colonial Vista Care Center. Betty was born September 7, 1923, to Henry and Christine (Marquardt) Weber at Dryden, WA,

where she grew up and received her education. Betty would often share stories

about growing up on an apple orchard with seven siblings and the many adventures they had as a family. On January 17, 1944, Betty married Elmer Schillereff at San Diego, CA.

For the next ten years, they lived in Seattle, WA. They returned to Wenatchee in 1954, where they resided until their move to Twisp, WA, in 1963, when they purchased and ran a grocery store for approximately five years. In 1968, the family moved back to Wenatchee, where they owned and operated the B&E Market. Betty loved to cook and for 12 years, she worked at Central Washington

Hospital in the food service department as a cook. After her retirement, she found much joy in volunteering for Aging and Adult Services for two years.

Betty was preceded in death by her parents, Henry and Christine Weber; six of

her siblings; husband, Elmer; son, Michael; and daughter-in-law, Judy

Schillereff. She is survived by two daughters: Patricia (Fred) Waunch of Cashmere, WA, and Christine Schillereff of Edmonds, WA; brother, Walt Weber of Sayward, B.C., Canada; along with seven grandchildren: Rick Stillwaugh (Tammy), Debby Hambrick (Bill), Joshua Schillereff (Nicole), Adam Rath Schillereff, Andrew Schillereff, Gary Waunch (Mindy), Eric Waunch (Deanna); and eight great-grandchildren: Alex Stillwaugh (Gina), Hannah and Jacob Stillwaugh, Kylie and Josh Schillereff, Sawyer Waunch, Camille and Wyatt Waunch.
