



## Bob Wisemore

January 26, 1927 - June 26, 2010

Bob Wisemore, 83, died Saturday, June 26, 2010. He was born in Wynne, AR, on January 26, 1927, to O.F. "Buck" and Lucille (McFarlen) Wisemore. He lived and was educated in Leavenworth and Wenatchee, WA. He joined the Navy in 1944, and served in the Pacific. He married Dorothy Dean Davis on January 7, 1946, in East Wenatchee, before he was discharged in June of 1946. He worked for Chelan County PUD for 29 years, and was Superintendent of Central Maintenance for Rocky Reach Dam, Rock Island Dam, Chelan Falls, Dryden and the powerhouse at Stehekin. He was a member of the IBEW 77. Bob and Dorothy lived on South Shore Road in Chelan, WA for a time after Bob retired in 1976. Later, they traveled to Indio, CA for 13 years, during the winter months. In 1987, they came home to East Wenatchee to stay. He loved motorcycling and took many trips to Canada, Montana, throughout California, Arizona and around the Indio area. Bob had a stroke on December 19, 1995. He and his wife had celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary two days before because the family couldn't be together on January 7, 1996. Bob lived at Colonial Vista for 13 1/2 years and watched a lot of friends come and go.

He was preceded in death by his mother and father. Bob is survived by his wife of 64 years, Dorothy; three children, Michael (Robelyn) Wisemore of Lincoln, WA, Stephen (Kelli) Wisemore of East Wenatchee and Rebecca (Pat) Allen of East Wenatchee; three grandchildren, Michelle Slade, Mark (Tena)

Wisemore and Paul (Laura) Rhodes; and six great-grandchildren, Dannica Slade, Micah Slade, McKenna Rhodes, Serene Rhodes, Seth Wisemore and Olivia Wisemore.
