Clarence C. Frantz, 92, passed away at home Thursday, February 14, 2013, at his home in Arlington, WA. Born in Edgar, NE to James C. Frantz and Beulah Caldwell Frantz, he was a beloved son, brother, husband, father, grandfather and uncle.

In 1947, he married Eula Scoggins and they made their home in Manson, WA, later moving to Lake Chelan, WA. Clarence continued working in the apple orchard industry until retirement, when he and Eula moved to Wenatchee, WA and celebrated 63 years of marriage. In 2009, Clarence and Eula moved to

Arlington, WA to be near their daughter and family. Clarence loved the outdoors, where he spent many hours in his retirement gardening and bird watching.
