MSgt. Ernest C Bennett left his earthly bonds to join his wife Kathie on Feb. 21 2025 at Central Washington Hospital after a long illness. He was born at Camp Lejune, N.C. to LT. Col. and Mrs. E.C. Bennett Sr. in September 1943. He went into the USAF three days after graduating high school and served for over 20 years and a Vietnam Veteran with Commendations. He retired in 1981.
