David T. Mumm, of East Wenatchee, WA, passed away peacefully at home on December 22, 2010, while surrounded by his family. David was born in Hutchinson, KS on September 4, 1951, to Joseph and Florence Mumm. His family moved to Washington, where he spent most of his childhood in the Clearview/Cathcart area of Snohomish. After graduating from Snohomish High School in 1969, David served four years in the Air Force. On December 19, 1970, he married Patricia Mason. David ran the machine shop with precision and skill and enjoyed the challenges of being a Hydro Machinist and, most of all, working with all the great people at Central Maintenance, Rocky Reach and Rock Island Dams. David loved spending time with his family. He coached Jenny's team in soccer, competed in Billiards competitions together and then they raced Odysseys and Mini Sprints together for ten

years. They won many championships and developed a strong father/daughter bond. He enjoyed his vacations, whether it was camping, a weekend getaway, or taking cruises. But most of all, he enjoyed entertaining friends and family at home, barbecuing on the deck and swimming in his pool. David's two grandsons, Matthew and Dylan, became his best buddies. They came over from Marysville and spent every summer swimming, fishing, flying kites, golfing and working on the VW bug. He so loved being their Papa! David and Patty celebrated their 40th Anniversary on December 19, 2010.
