March 2, 1931 - July 9, 2016

Doris Louise (Trentini) Hanan, 85, died peacefully at home on July 9, 2016 following a courageous ten-year battle with Alzheimer's and sixty years of her life coping with Type I diabetes. Doris was laid to rest at the Trentini Family plot at Riverside Cemetery in Milford, New Hampshire.

Doris was born on March 2, 1931 to Mario and Helga Trentini in Lynn, Massachusetts. After graduating Lynn High School, Doris attended Lynn Hospital School of Nursing. Doris survived by husband Jim, three children: Linda (Bill) Dobbins of East Wenatchee, WA; Jeffrey (Laura) Hanan of Charlton, NY; Kristen (Jim) Kennedy of Richardson, TX. She has 8 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren. Her sister Ruth Froeberg resides in Sunnyvale, CA with her two children and their families.

Doris's family will remember her as a dynamic lady. She had a talent for geriatric nursing and a love for her family, friends, and dogs.
