Doris June Stubblefield, passed away on November 22, 2011. Born to Carl and Rose Zeeh in Eustis, Nebraska on June 8, 1929, she was raised on the family farm and was a member of the Eustis Lutheran Church. After high school graduation, Doris taught elementary school in Orfino, NE. As the story goes, she was in charge of a one room school house and was entrusted with the education K-8th grade pupils in addition to keeping the wood stove burning.

After WWII she met and married Dale Stubblefield and they had four children Dalette, Debbie, Denise, and Mike. They worked together on the family farm, then moving back to Eustis where they opened a butcher shop.

Upon the passing of Doris' parents, they sold the butcher shop and took over the farm. They also owned and operated Doris' Café in the small community of Eustis. They sold everything in 1962 and moved to the Wenatchee Valley in 1963. There Doris worked at the Owl Café, Fox & Hound's, Rooney's Café, Doris' Spudnut Shop, The Hut, and eventually ending up at Top Foods in the Deli Department. She enjoyed working in the food service industry and had enjoyed her co-workers and customers. It was not unusual for her to welcome customers who did not have families during holidays to enjoy a meal in her home.

She enjoyed cooking, pie making, baking all sorts of cakes, candy making and having coffee waiting for the "working" early birds in her years at the restaurants.

At home she was fond of gardening, embroidery work, crocheting, completing crossword puzzles, and watching the Mariners and Seahawks.

She was preceded in death by her husband Dale and her daughter Debbie. She is survived by her sister Ginger Anderson; her children: Allen & Dalette Hobart , Scott & Denise Gere, Michael & Sharon Stubblefield, her grandchildren: Michael & Janelle Norris, Brad Long, and Colin & Heather Hill. And one special great granddaughter Noelle Hill who stole Grammy Do Do's heart from us all.
