



## Dorothy Rose Lenny

October 15, 1930 - August 14, 2017

Dorothy Rose (Hayter) Lenny, age 86, of Wenatchee, WA, passed away in her sleep at Blossom Creek Care Center, on Monday, August 14, 2017, after a long battle with Alzheimer's Dementia. Bert and Dorothy were married September 16, 2000, in the Wenatchee Church of the Nazarene. Surviving are Bert at home; daughter, Gini Bork of Rockford, IL; and granddaughter, Celeste Love of McChesney Park, IL.
