



## Edna Marie Blue

October 18, 1920 - September 22, 2010

Edna M. Blue, 89, a longtime resident of East Wenatchee, WA, died Wednesday, September 22, 2010, at Highline Care Center in East Wenatchee. Mrs. Blue was born October 18, 1920, to Ernest C. and Carla A. (Olson) Quick at Zillah, WA, where she lived until her marriage. She graduated from Toppenish High School and Central Washington College of Education (formerly Washington State Normal School and later, Central Washington University) in Ellensburg, and taught school until her marriage. On January 9, 1945, she married Chester L. Blue at Toppenish. Their first home was in Seattle, then Omak, moving to East Wenatchee in June 1955. Mrs. Blue retired, after 27 years, from Alcoa, on January 1, 1983. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in East Wenatchee and Soroptimist International of Wenatchee.

Mrs. Blue is survived by her great-granddaughters, Lettie Marie and Reba Elaine Blue, both of Wenatchee. She was preceded in death by her husband on April 19, 1996; her son, Robert in 1984; grandson, Eric in 2009; one brother; and her parents.
