Edna McCandlish Standerfer, 89, passed away December 19, 2009, at the home of her son, Lorne McCandlish. She was born July 4, 1920, at the family home in East Wenatchee. Her mother, Zella (Zimmerman) Marr, was born and raised in the Squilchuck area in the late 1800's, and her father, Wibur Marr, came west from Ohio to settle in East Wenatchee. Edna was educated in East Wenatchee and graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1938. In 1939, she married Lloydan McCandlish in Wenatchee, WA. They lived in Bremerton, Portland and Seattle, and had three children, Joan, Lorne and Michael. After Lloydan's death in 1956, she returned to East Wenatchee and built a home on part of her parent's old cow pasture. In 1957, Edna married Wayne Standerfer of East Wenatchee. They lived mostly in Seattle. She worked as a teacher's aide at a Lutheran preschool in Seattle for many years. Edna returned to Wenatchee in the 1990's.

Survivors include her children, Joan (Roy) Hinderer of East Wenatchee; Lorne (Jo) McCandlish of Wenatchee and Michael (Nancy) McCandlish of Bothell and step-son, Michael (Jan) Standerfer of San Diego, CA; sisters, Ethel Turnipseed and Peggy (Ron) Duncan of East Wenatchee; five grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husbands; two brothers, James and Emerson Marr of Wenatchee; and a sister, Helen Mulloy of Beaverton, OR.
