



## Eva Romey

September 13, 1925 - June 30, 2012

Eva E. Romey, 86, a 55 year Wenatchee Valley resident, passed away on Saturday, June 30, 2012 at the Colonial Vista following a brief illness. She was born on September 13, 1925 to Charles Ralph and Willa (Gilchrist) McClure at Hot Springs SD. She was raised on a ranch West of Hot Springs and graduated from Hot Springs High School in 1943. She was employed by a local bank until she married her long time childhood friend, Vernon Romey, on March 24, 1946.

Eva moved to the Wenatchee Valley with Vernon and their family in 1957. Soon thereafter she began working for the Peter Rabbit supermarket and worked there throughout its existence except for a brief period when she worked for Douglas County Bank.
