Evelyn N. (Wise) Farley slipped away quietly at Central Washington Hospital in the early morning of October 31, 2018 after a brief illness.

Evelyn Nadine Wise was born on May 25, 1923 to Earnest and Martha Wise in Ardenvoir, Washington. She had seven children.
