



## Gertrude Davis

August 29, 1918 - November 13, 2012

Gertrude Davis, 94, of Brewster, died Tuesday, November 13, 2012.

She was born and raised in Elmore City, Oklahoma and moved to Washington with her husband, Pete, and son, Glynn, in 1943. They eventually settled on the Bridgeport Bar in 1950 where they planted and maintained apple orchards for 40 years. They also owned and operated the Rocky Butte Service station from 1964 to 1970. Although her title was homemaker, she worked alongside her husband in the orchards and the service station. She was very supportive of school activities and a member of many clubs including the "Bar Belles".

While a member of the Bar Belles Gertrude was instrumental in organizing fund raising for the Robert Caldwell Memorial Fire Station on the Bar.

Survivors include two sons, Glynn Davis of Walla Walla and Gary Davis of Seabeck; two daughters, Jan Shrable of East Wenatchee and Deb LaMoreaux of Brewster; two sisters and one brother, Zella Murphy of Oklahoma City and Earlene Roberts and Skip Smith of Spokane. She is also survived by seven grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.

Graveside services will be at 10:30AM Monday, November 19th at the Fraternal Cemetery in Chelan.
