attending church faithfully ever since. In 1954, they moved to the Wenatchee Valley and resided here for 62 years.

Wayne and Gloria were married 72 years before Wayne passed away February 3, 2014. They were blessed with six children, along with 21 grandchildren, 35 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild. Family life with the Goodmans was full of fun, laughter and plenty of good food! Gloria was known as the best cook. There were innumerable family get-togethers with her cooking as the highlight. Gloria also enjoyed reading, canning, quilting and pinochle. She especially enjoyed the many friends she made in her later years playing pinochle on Tuesdays and Wednesdays with the seniors.
