Grace Burrell (Johnston) Day, 97, passed away on February 27, 2013, at Colonial Vista Care Center in Wenatchee, WA. She was born on July 18, 1915, in Twisp, WA, to Arthur J. and Zanie (Beeman) Johnston. She grew up in the Methow Valley and graduated from Winthrop High School in 1935. She married Eugene L. Day in 1936, and they made their home in Rock Island, WA, where they raised their four children. In 1959, she lost her husband unexpectedly. She got her LPN degree and went to work at Deaconess Hospital. She moved to Brewster in 1963, and worked at the Brewster Hospital and Care Center. She then moved to Winthrop and Malott to care for her mother, while still working at the Tillikum House Care Center in Okanogan, WA. She retired in 1976, and after her mother passed away, she lived in Cheney, Wilbur and Malott, before settling in Wenatchee, where she lived at Garden Terrace until she went to Colonial Vista in May of 2010.

She is survived by her children: daughter, Kathleen Hall (Kirk) of Rock Island, son, Garry Day (Peggy) of East Wenatchee, daughter, Patricia Roach (Ken) of Mount Vernon and daughter-in-law, Kathy Day of Malaga; one brother, Dave Johnston (Leona) of Apache Junction, AZ; nine grandchildren; 17 great-

grandchildren; three nephews; and one niece. She was preceded in death by her parents; husband; one son; two daughters-in-law; one brother; one nephew; and two grandsons.
