Greg was born on March 12, 1950, to Herb and Jean Logsdon in Wenatchee, WA. He died suddenly on October 23, 2016. He was 66 years old. Greg was a lifelong Wenatchee Valley resident, graduating from Eastmont High School in 1968. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Army serving in Germany in the 3rd Armored Division. Upon his discharge, he returned to Wenatchee, where he served as a volunteer firefighter for Douglas County Fire District #2 and attended Wenatchee Valley College, earning a degree in Agriculture.
