Harold W. Howerton, 96, of Wenatchee passed away early December 6, 2016 at Central Washington Hospital. He was born on November 19, 1920 to Frank and Zerpha (Johnson) Howerton in Leavenworth.

He attended school in Leavenworth and North Kitsap in Poulsbo where the family moved to. He worked for Pope & Talbert Sawmill, Port Gamble until he joined the Navy in 1944.
