She returned to Wenatchee in 1944, where she attended Western College of Commerce, and then worked at the Selective Service Office in the Chelan County Courthouse, until she quit to wed Lawrence H. Morgan. They married at Ohme Gardens on May 11, 1946. Later, she worked in the office of the small tractor and equipment shop that she and her husband owned. Aunt Peggy had a heart of gold and could give the biggest bear hugs for being such a tiny lady, and that is something that she did not like to hear from anyone, that she was TINY!!
