He held his head high and managed the condition as best he could. He had a wide variety of friends, who he spent his free time with. He had a soft spot in his heart for people who had to deal with chronic pain, the same way he did. Jake enjoyed making people laugh and pulling as many practical jokes as he could, then he would look at you with a "Who me?" expression. He will be missed more than words can ever express.
