



James B. Malloy

June 25, 1918 - August 6, 2017

On Sunday, August 6, 2017, James, usually known as "Bud", Malloy of East Wenatchee, WA, passed away peacefully at the age of 99, at his home, with friends and his caregiver, Cassandra, at his side.

Bud was born in Duluth, MN, on June 25, 1918, to Frances Pauline Commiskey-Malloy and William Michael Malloy. Bud and Evelyn Jean Volker were married on November 20, 1943, in Highland, WI. Their son, James "Jim" Gilbert Malloy was born on June 15, 1948, in Muscogee, OK.

Bud joined the U.S. Army Air Force during World War II, learning to fly airplanes, a passion he continued to enjoy long after the war. When the war ended, Bud was employed by the Wisconsin Civilian Conservation Corps and later on, he did construction work, learning skills that he would use throughout his life. Bud was employed by the Federal Aviation Agency, first in Seattle, WA, then in Portland, OR, and Redmond, OR, until he retired from the FAA in Wenatchee, WA.

Bud is survived by his caregiver, Cassandra Ward of Wenatchee, WA; brother-
