James W. Wyatt Sr., 82, of Wenatchee, passed away on Sunday, January 17, 2010. He was born April 24, 1927, to James and Mildred Wyatt of Sidney, IA. James enlisted in the Navy on May 16, 1944, and served until the end of the Second World War. After returning home, he enlisted in the Army on November 8, 1946. After leaving the Army, he became a steel worker. In 1957, he met and married Golda Knutson, his wife of 53 years. They had three children, James, Chester and Veronica. The family moved to Wenatchee in 1963, where E. T. Pybus employed James as a welder fabricator. He loved fishing and the outdoors, along with a passion for motorcycles. He opened Wyatt's Harley Davidson in the early 1960's. He was also a life member of the American Legion and past Commander of Post 10 in Wenatchee from 1987 through 1990, where he helped bring about the construction of the new Post 10 building that members now enjoy.

Survivors include his wife, Golda Mae Wyatt; his children, John Wyatt, James Wyatt Jr., Chester Wyatt and Veronica Hosfeld; seven grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; a brother, Kenneth Wyatt; and sisters, Debby Bennit and Phyllis Rowe.
