Jerry J. Bartram went to be with Lord, on May 28, 2021. Jerry was born on September 18, 1936, in Wheeler, TX, to Homer and Lena Bartram. In 1937, the Bartram's moved to North Amarillo, TX, to run a 21-section cattle ranch, where Jerry had many fond memories. He enjoyed playing basketball in school, where he met Margaret in the seventh grade. Jerry and Margaret were married on February 8, 1954, at 16 & 17 in Portales, NM, 50 years after Jerry's grandparents were married there. They farmed in Lockney, TX, where they had two sons and one daughter. At the age of 28, Jerry was given the Outstanding Young Farmer Award through the Young Farmers Association. In 1968, they moved to East Wenatchee, WA, where they owned and operated an apple orchard. Jerry loved the Lord very much. He was a longtime member at Wenatchee Valley Baptist and later, at Eastmont Baptist Church. He served as head usher and deacon at both churches from 1971-2013. In the church, he prided himself on knowing everyone's name. Jerry was a fun loving man with quick wit and sarcasm that everyone loved to be around. He always had a joke up his

sleeve or a story to tell. He loved being active in church, even after he stepped down from his positions. Jerry was loved by many people, and he loved spending time with his family and close friends.
