Jesse Devitt Tollackson, 30, of Waterville, passed away on June 14, 2024. Jesse was born February 11, 1994 to Ron & Jona Tollackson in Wenatchee and was raised in Waterville. Jesse attended Waterville School from Pre-K through his senior year, where he enjoyed choir, band, golf, and football. Unbeknownst to most, Jesse could sing and was one heck of a drummer; his love for music never left. After graduating high school, Jesse attended North Idaho College to pursue a degree in HVAC, where he excelled in his career. Jesse spent a few years living in Idaho before moving back to Waterville to be closer to family and friends.

Growing up, Jesse was known as “Chatman” because he never stopped talking, a trait that carried on throughout his life.
