Juan Carlos Gómez Pineda, age 44, passed away at home on Sunday, January 22, 2023, surrounded by his family. Juan was born on May 10, 1978, in Los Angeles, CA. He was a long-time resident of the Wenatchee Valley.

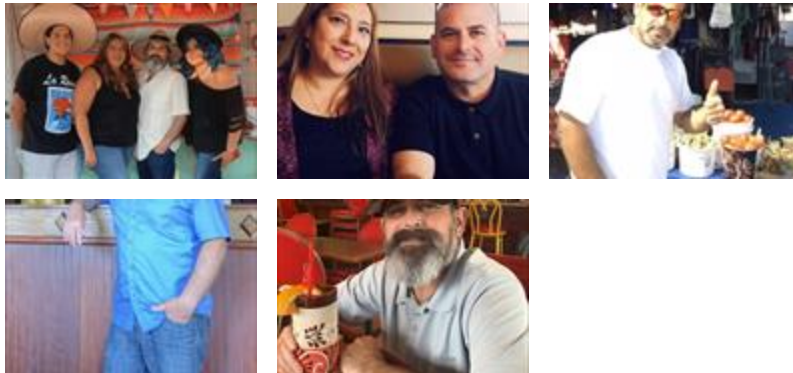
