Judith G. "Judy" Brown, age 70, of East Wenatchee, WA, passed away November 19, 2010. She was born in Wenatchee on August 5, 1940, to Joseph and Ella Overbay, and was raised and attended schools in Manson. She graduated from Manson High School in 1958, then moved to Seattle to attend the Mary Stone School of Beauty. While living there, she met John L. Brown and they married on June 2, 1960. The couple had two daughters, Kellie and Dana Jean. In 1963, the family moved to Medford, OR; then, in 1965, they moved back to Wenatchee. She then worked at Theodore's and Marilyn's Fashions at the Wenatchee Valley Mall and, in the late 1980's, was also a Mall Model. Judy was a member of Grace Lutheran Church and spent much of her later life lovingly volunteering there, including Worship Team, Quilters of Grace and Alter Guild, taking precious care of the paraments.
