



## Katherine Adele Stallman

November 5, 1919 - December 19, 2012

Katherine Adele Stallman, 93, a longtime resident of Wenatchee, WA, passed away peacefully Wednesday, December 19, 2012. Katherine was born November 5, 1919, to Harry and Bertha Lampert on the family farm near Worley, ID. She joined two older brothers, Ralph and Ed. Three years later, her younger sister, Bernice, joined the family. Katherine grew up on the family farm, graduating from Worley High School in 1938. After high school, she moved to Coeur d'Alene, ID, where she met her husband-to-be, Robert "Bob" Stallman. They first lived in Coeur d'Alene, where their first daughter and a son were born. Later, they lived in the Grand Coulee area and Bridgeport, after Robert became a painter on hydro-electric dams. The family next moved to Wenatchee, which Katherine has called home for over 50 years. Although Wenatchee was their home base, they also traveled to many interesting construction sites throughout the west where Bob worked, making many friends along the way.

Katherine was a member of the Wenatchee Eagles Auxiliary for many years. She was also a member of the First United Methodist Church here in Wenatchee.

Katherine was preceded in death by her husband in 1994; as well as by her two older brothers, Ed and Ralph. She is survived by her daughters, Marilyn McComas (Douglas) of Wenatchee and Diann Robards (Steve) of East

Wenatchee; her son, Dale Stallman (Linda) of Vancouver, WA; and her sister, Bernice Ent of Spokane. She is also survived by five grandchildren, Kevin McComas of Seattle, Wendy Robards of Seattle, Leanne Miller of East Wenatchee, Todd Stallman of Vancouver and Shannon Yount, also of Vancouver. Other survivors include nine great-grandchildren, Travis, Skyler, Erin, Wyatt, Cole, Ryder, Cameron, Maddie and Kaitlyn; and many nieces and nephews.

The family wishes to thank her longtime physician, Dr. David Houghland, and the doctors, nurses and support staff at Central Washington Hospital for Katherine's wonderful care.
