Kenneth W. Felton, born October 9, 1927, went to meet the Lord on March 16, 2011, at the age of 83. He was born in Rogersville, MO, where he met his wife of 59 years, Dorothy, (their 60th anniversary would be March 26, 2011). Kenneth was a beloved Husband, Dad and Grandpa and was loved by everyone who knew him. Early in life, he moved his family from Missouri to Oroville, WA, where he worked in the orchards and sheds, until he went to work for the City of Oroville.
