



## Kirk Slatta

April 30, 1967 - July 11, 2023

Kirk Kenneth Slatta of East Wenatchee, WA passed away at Central Washington Hospital on July 11th, 2023, at 4:07 pm. He passed peacefully surrounded by his wife, two children, and with their significant others.

Kirk was born at Saint Antony's Hospital on April 30th, 1967, in Wenatchee, Washington to his loving parents Lauren Eugene Slatta and Corrine Adeline Pfau. Kirk was the surviving of premature twins at 3lbs and a collapsed lung. Unfortunately, his twin Kent passed after birth at 1.5 lbs.
