Lin Stimus, age 66, was a longtime East Wenatchee, WA resident. Lin was born in Alexandria, LA. At age six, she moved to Pollock Pines, CA, where she finished her education and worked her first job as a Data Entry Programmer. Her love for the outdoors sent her down a new path. She moved to East Wenatchee in 1967. After a few years at Dolco, she established her own painting and roofing company, Lin's Roofing. She was one of the first female roofers in the state of Washington. Her second business kept her busy, raising apples and cherries on her ranch. She loved her family, both two and four legged. Her dog, Ranger, passed with her, staying by her side to the very end of his life. Lin loved to hunt and fish. She played a mean game of softball. She was a true and faithful friend with a great, generous nature.

Lin is survived by her sister, Anna Finstad (Blake) of San Juan Bautista, CA; nephews, Christopher Finstad (Shaunna) and Jason Finstad of San Juan Bautista, CA; one niece, Sarah Finstad Krawisz (Ryan) of Lake Elsinore, CA; and great nieces, Mackenzie and Hailey.
