



## Lucille Lucidia White

August 8, 1919 - July 20, 2019

Our mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, Lucille Lucidia White, was called home by our Heavenly Father on July 20, 2019, just shy of her 100th birthday. She was born in Holdingford, MN, on August 8, 1919, to Stanley and Blanche Winskowski. Lucy was one of 12 children. She worked during the war at the Seattle Shipyard as a welder. Lucy met her life partner, Paul, and they were married on March 6, 1943.

Lucy was very involved in church activities, serving as Eucharistic Minister, helping Paul with St. Vincent De Paul food bank, and was involved in St. Anne's Guild. Mom worked at nearly every tavern in town as a bartender and bouncer. Later in life, she and her husband, Paul, both worked in packing sheds.
