Lynn Clem Elmer Battermann, lifelong Wenatchee native & resident, went to be with the Lord on September 12, 2021. He passed away at Central Washington Hospital in Wenatchee, WA from Covid. Born in 1936 Lynn was 85. Educated as a Civil Engineer Lynn ran a construction and engineering company in Wenatchee for many years. To the surprise and shock of many (including the family) Lynn moved the family to Saudi Arabia in 1978 to work for Aramco. In 1985 he and Jacky, his loving wife of 62 years, took early retirement and went into full time Christian missions work for the next 36 years using their engineering and administrative skills to help charitable organizations all over the world and across the United States. Never one for retiring Lynn was busy right up until his brief sickness helping anyone he could. There are countless thousands who benefited from his eager willingness to share God's love through endless acts of kindness and volunteer work.
