Dean was born on October 29, 1934, to Will and May (Barnes) Percy at home, near Mt. Pleasant, AR. He went to his Heavenly home on March 29, 2014, at home. He went into the Army on September 11, 1957, at Fort Chaffee, AR. He was honorably discharged on October 18, 1957. He went to work for Ford Motor Company in Dearborn, MI, testing farm tractors and equipment. He settled in Washington in 1967, working in various orchards, fruit sheds and agriculture. On May 3, 1970, he married Nancy Kuhlmann; they would have been married 44 years. In April 1972, they bought their home in East Wenatchee, WA, building onto it and lived there 42 years, where they planted and ran a small nectarine and peach orchard at their home. Dean retired as Orchard Manager for McDougall & Sons in 1983. In 1973, Dean accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior, thanks to Pastor Norm Steuckle.
