July 26, 1927 - October 14, 2010

Marion Traylor, age 83, of Wenatchee, WA, fell asleep in the Lord October 14, 2010. She was born Marion Shirley Onesha Humphrey on July 26, 1927, at York, WI. She graduated from Hixton High School. After graduation, she graduated from the Milwaukee School of Beauty at Eau Claire, WI. In 1947, she came to Wenatchee to live with an aunt, Mrs. Del P. Case. She attended Western College of Commerce, then later worked for the Veteran's Administration and the Office of Rent Control. Marion retired from Wenatchee Valley College after 32 years of dedicated service. During those years, she was an Assistant to the Dean of Instruction, Secretary to the President and the Department Coordinator for the Nursing Department. When she retired, a tree was planted in her honor on the college campus. In 1950, Marion was the Appleatchee Princess representative to the Ellensburg Rodeo. Her treasure was family; her strength was in the LORD, who blessed her with a loving, kind and gentle heart. She was the love of our lives and the family hers. She would get giddy with delight knowing a family member was coming for a visit. Her home was the hub of family togetherness, with lots of cooking, laughter and genuine unconditional love. She married Wayland Traylor in 1971; together, they ran a small cherry orchard and lived in one of the oldest homes in the Valley for over 38 years. In 1951, she was baptized into Christ and attended the Church of God Faith of Abraham. Marion later attended Calvary Bible Church for over 25 years. Then, in the later years, Marion and Wayland joined the Messiah Fellowship, whose focus was jail ministry. We miss your warm
