



Marvin Fenner

March 20, 1935 - August 23, 2015

On Sunday, August 23, 2015, Marvin Rolland Fenner passed away peacefully with his sons next to him, after a long confinement inside the disease of Alzheimers. He was born in Powell, WY on March 20, 1935, to Bessie (Baker) and Rolland Fenner. He was one of eight children, always proud to say "four boys and four girls". In 1946, at the age of 11, the family moved to the Deer Park, WA area for the summer and then to East Wenatchee, WA for three years, before settling in Mansfield, WA. Marvin left school in 1952, when his brother, LeRoy, graduated and he joined the Navy in the Buddy Program, leaving with an honorable discharge. On September 8, 1957, he married Donna Lautenslager in Pateros, WA and was blessed with sons, Jay J. in 1958 and Tracy Lee in 1959. After their divorce, he married Vonsielle Juette on January 25, 1975, adding to the family sons, Mike Acord, Randy Juette, and Ron Juette, and daughter, Elaine Goodman. At this time, he graduated from Oregon Meat Cutting School in Cottage Grove, OR. He worked as a butcher for many years in Omak, Manson and Chelan, WA. He later worked at Dolco Packaging in Wenatchee and at Stemilt Growers until his retirement in 1997.

Marvin was preceded in death by his parents; sister, Geraldine; brother, Bob; and his beloved wife, Vonsielle. He is survived by his children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews. He loved us all very much.
