Mildred C. Tomlinson, 90, of East Wenatchee, passed away peacefully Monday Nov.24, 2014 at the extended care facility at which she was residing. Mildred was born in Wagner, So. Carolina on Nov. 22, 1924. Mildred graduated Valedictorian of her class in 1941 from Wagner High School. Following graduation she moved to Fort Benning, GA to work as a military chauffeur during World War 2. While working as a chauffeur, she met and fell in love with Private Ralph Tomlinson. The two married January 1, 1944. Their first son, Daryl, was born at Fort Gordon, Ga. while they were stationed there. Two years later their son Craig was born in Cartersville, GA. The family moved to Washington in 1952 where their son Randy and daughter, Marci were both born.

Mildred was a stay at home mom, she enjoyed cooking southern food, raising German Shorthaired Pointers, her two favorites were Barney and Roamer who entertained many guests at the house. She loved tending her garden, and cheering her kids on at baseball games. Her home was not just a revolving door for people, but for all of the wild and domestic critters her children brought home, such as a coyote, a skunk, a big horn owl, cats, dogs, and numerous lizards and insects. Her greatest passion in life was taking care of her children and grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Ralph Tomlinson in 1986. Survivors include Daryl Tomlinson (Ravelle), Craig Tomlinson (Kathy), Marci Walker (Ray), Randy, and 12 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren. She is

survived by a brother William Collum in Wagner, So. Carolina. She is preceded in death by her parents ET Collum and Lizzie Lee Collum and 3 brothers, Marian, Dorsey, and Robert all in So. Carolina.
