Patrick was born March 18 1956 in Tacoma WA and moved with his family to the Wenatchee Valley in 1966. He was residing in East Wenatchee at the time of his death.

Pat attended Eastmont Grade school and Pioneer Middle School Special Education Programs until 1974. He then worked for many years for Supervised Skills and was an excellent employee.

As a teenager, Pat was a member of the Lucky Clover 4H Club where he raised and showed beef cattle. His steer, Herbie, won Grand Champion in 1968.

As an active participant in Special Olympics in skiing, track, basketball and softball, Pat won several medals. Patrick exemplified the Special Olympics motto - "Let me win but if I cannot win, let me be brave in the attempt." Upon returning to the Wenatchee area from Portland in 2007, he continued to participate in Special Olympics and recently won a gold medal in Basketball Skills.

Patrick loved to watch football, baseball and basketball and could list the team statistics and records for the Mariners and Seahawks at any time. He would voice his opinion loudly regarding team trades and game scores to anyone who would listen. He collected hats and was proud of his collection. Lately, Patrick went bowling every Monday and loved to play the game. He rolled the

ball so hard he could make a strike no matter where the ball hit the pins. He is survived by his mother, Jean Wrzesinski of East Wenatchee, brother Rick Wrzesinski (Cheryl) of Beaverton OR, sister Kathy Freeman (Tony) of Royal Slope WA, sister Kimberly Wrzesinski of Portland OR and sister Christine Wrzesinski of Washington DC as well as many nieces, nephews and relatives.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 11am on Friday March 15, 2013 at Holy Apostles Catholic Church in East Wenatchee with a reception to follow.
