“ I worked for Paul about 35 years ago. I always found him to be a man of great integrity. If Paul gave his word, you could count on him. We worked some really long hours, but it was always an adventure. The most memorable was when starting an old Farmall H tractor. It was too small and old to be of much value, but it pulled a large propane tank and was used to burn weeds on ditch banks. The battery was dead, so we used jumper cables. Shortly, we discovered it was completely out of gas. Paul handed me the nozzle from the 250 gallon tank in the back of the pick-up. When I touched the nozzle to the tractor's tank, there was a small spark. A small flame burned on the fumes from the tank right at the filler neck. I slapped my palm on the neck, hoping to suffocate the flame. All I know for sure is my heart raced and I survived unscathed.

This wasn't the only eye opening, heart pounding adventure working for Paul, but it had the greatest potential for a disastrous ending. In each case, Paul was never rattled, gave a great, heart felt laugh and moved on.

I lost track of the Clarks but will keep memories filled with respect for the family, but especially of Paul. I never saw Paul waver in his belief in the salvation of Christ, and the forgiveness of sin. This is the source of Paul's strength and moral character.
