She joined in on hunting and fishing trips, often guiding to the perfect location to find the game. She enjoyed her grandchildren fully as they came along, caring for the little ones and teaching and having fun with them as they got older. She offered genuine and sincere friendship throughout her life, and was rewarded with special friends, whom she treasured.

Peggy was preceded in death by her parents; four brothers; and two sisters. She is survived by her loving and devoted husband of 58 years, Cyril May; her four children, Rex May and wife, Jeanne, Randy May and wife, Wendy, Teresa Colberg and husband, Steve, and Ryan May and wife, Chelsea; her nine grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
