The next 30 years she worked at Wenatchee Valley Medical Center helping patients. Most of her career was in the walk-in clinic, but spent time in many other departments throughout the clinic. Many lifelong friendships began at the clinic. During that time Priss married Scott Mc Dougall, they were married for several years. As a young woman she loved downhill skiing, and then took up crosscountry skiing, never turned down a racquet ball game, and enjoyed daily walks. After work and on weekend she spent many hours at the Keane Ranch riding horses, rounding up cattle and helping on the ranch. Branding day at the Keane Ranch was one of her favorite days of the year. Her job was to vaccinate all of the calves, a friend or two always came along to help. Many holidays and vacation were spent with Steve, Jane and their family. Priss was a very active person and loved being out in the open country, if it was on her horse that was even better. A unique bond was formed between Priss and her horse, often referring to him as her therapy. The many horseback rides into the high county with great friends held a special place in her heart.
