



## Richard A. Jaspers

November 28, 1939 - July 3, 2017

Richard (Dick) A. Jaspers, age 77, a long time resident of East Wenatchee, passed away Monday, July 3, 2017, at his home.

He was born on November 28, 1939 in Humphrey, Nebraska, to Leo and Madeline Jaspers. He was raised and attended school in both East Wenatchee and Wenatchee, graduating from Wenatchee High School in 1957.
