Bob was born December 15, 1947 to Ralph and Evelyn (Cox) Puckett in Manson, WA

and passed away in East Wenatchee on December 23, 2015. He already had older

siblings: Jack Kinney, Lola (Kinney) Benson and Kenneth Kinney. He grew up in

the Chelan area and graduated from Chelan High School. Soon after high school,

he was drafted into the Army and found himself visiting Viet Nam. While in the Army, he had training in helicopter mechanics, which became his lifelong trade. After returning to the U.S., he spent the remainder of his career with Cascade Helicopter and Falcon West Helicopter, with a few small breaks in between. Bob was married twice; first to Dian (Bowers) Puckett, then to Susan (Kuster) Puckett. There were no children from these unions, but he did have several four-legged companions, Molly P and Babe, to name a few, who he treated like they were his children.

Bob was preceded in death by both his parents. He leaves behind his siblings,

aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and many good friends. Although there were many demons that Bob faced along the way with several medical issues, he did begin to find peace in the later part of his life and had joined the Calvary Bible Church.
