After WWII, she traveled extensively by auto, with her mother, through the United States, Canada and Mexico. Ruth then moved to Southern California in 1949 and was employed by Hughes Aircraft as an electronic assembler. She married Charles L. Mason in 1958. She attended College of the Canyons in New Hall, CA, then moved to this area with her husband in 1978. A long time advocate of environmental issues, Ruth actively supported the Nature Conservancy, Audubon Society, Arbor Day Foundation, Friends of the Trees, and the local Humane Society. She was a member of the Stemilt Hill Grange.

She was preceded in death by her sister, Elisabeth Berthold.
