Stella Mary (Jaspers) Weaver died in her home on Tuesday, March 5, 2013, surrounded by her family. She was born on January 27, 1930, to Leo and Magdalene (Schmitz) Jaspers in Humphrey, NE. She moved with her family to Orondo, WA in 1940. Her family later moved to East Wenatchee in 1945, where she attended school. She graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1948. Stella married Howard Paul Weaver on November 23, 1949, in Wenatchee, making their first home in East Wenatchee. They built a home in Douglas County near Rocky Reach Dam and lived there for ten years. In 1967, she moved with her family to Okanogan and helped her husband with their orchard until his death in 1989. She then moved back to the Wenatchee area, where in the year 2000, she met her next partner in life, Gordon Boender. Together, they explored the 11 dams of the Columbia River, traveled extensively in Europe and took care of each other.

Stella is survived by one son, Michael Weaver (Patty) of Albuquerque, NM; and four daughters, Donna Weaver (Don) of Seattle, WA, Deanne Konsack (John) of Okanogan, WA, Lynn Weaver Juchmes (Jerry) of East Wenatchee and Joan Philmon (Dennis) of Columbia Falls, MT. Stella is also survived by

ten grandchildren and six great-grandchildren; one sister, Rose Mary Barnaby of Wenatchee, WA; one brother, Dick Jaspers of East Wenatchee, WA; and her sister-in-law, Dotty Jo Jaspers of Wenatchee, WA. Stella was preceded in death by her husband, Howard; her parents; and her brother, Don.
