She enjoyed singing in the church choir, volunteer church activities, and helping at the Humane Society. One of her favorite activities was accompanying Roy, an art vendor, up to "Art in the Park" in Leavenworth, where he sells his stunning landscape and inspirational photography during the tourist season. Tammy and Roy have long been a part of a small church group that meets one evening a week which, in their group, includes a potluck dinner with group discussion later. Tammy will be greatly missed by family and friends. She was always ready to give or receive a hug,

and made friends everywhere she went.

She was preceded in death by her parents; and older brother, Ted. She is survived by her husband, Roy; her brother, Tim and his wife, Leslie, and their two daughters, Alorah and Kamryn.
