With the help of Darci & Kinda, Viv found both of her birth families. She was lucky to have met them and enjoyed wonderful relationships with them. What could have been an awkward situation turned into an amazing, comfortable & wonderful bond. It brought her so much joy having 1 sister and 6 brothers as she was an only child growing up.
