Warren Lester Gandy, a longtime resident of the Wenatchee area, born November 2, 1920, quietly passed away Saturday, October 22, 2011, in his home in Wenatchee, with his son and caregiver, Robert Gandy of Wenatchee and his loving daughter, Mary Longley of Ketchum, ID, at his side. He was preceded in death by his wife, Irmengard Gandy, in 1999.

Warren was born in Simmons, KY and grew up in Morgantown, WV, where he attended West Virginia University. He was a Veteran of World War II and a career Army Sergeant. He retired from the Army in 1965, when he and his family moved to East Wenatchee. He eventually went to work for Alcoa and retired from there in 1985. He and Irmengard loved the Wenatchee Valley and spent many hours hiking and backpacking in the surrounding mountains. Warren was an avid fly fisherman and photographer, and enjoyed playing the accordion and piano.
