Wayne Mason O'Brian, fifth and youngest child born to Eunice Marion [Gladstone] and Carman Burt 'Mike' O'Brian in Ogdensburg, NY, (7/23/1958) entered into rest on August 5, 2018, in Wenatchee, WA after an extended illness. Wayne moved to Wenatchee, WA when he was 2 years old, then to Colusa, CA where he lived until he graduated from Colusa High School in 1977, and then moved to Tucson, AZ with his mom. Wayne started his career in Colusa as a meat cutter working for Frank's Meats, then continued that career in Tucson and at Safeway in Wenatchee and finished his meat-cutting career as the meat manager at the Cashmere Safeway until it's closing.

Wayne then worked with his dad and brother Steve as an industrial painter and sandblaster, finally owning his own industrial/residential sandblasting and painting company. Wayne met and married his wife of 36 years, Tammi [McGee] in 1982. They had three children, Krystin, Amelynda (Ame), and Daniel (Danny). The family moved to the Entiat Valley in the early 1990's, where Wayne resided until his death.
