



William D. MacIntyre

William D. "Bill" MacIntyre, 74, of East Wenatchee, died Friday, June 3, 2011. He was a former longtime resident of Waterville and Mansfield. He had served in the Navy during the Korean War, being honorably discharged in 1958. In December of 1958, he joined the U.S. Coast Guard, where he was injured during his service and was honorably discharged in 1960. Bill was a lifetime member of the Disabled American Veterans. He had been a machinist for Mantel Gear Works and Boeing in Seattle, a barber in Kent and Waterville, and a custodian at the Douglas County Courthouse in Waterville.

Survivors include his wife, Kathryn MacIntyre of East Wenatchee; his children, Sandra (Tracy) Appel of Wenatchee, Susan (Scott) Wilson of Tustin, CA and Carmen Ikerd of East Wenatchee; and his brothers, Martin (Elsie) MacIntyre of Mansfield and Robert (Denise) MacIntyre of Gold Beach, OR; and seven grandchildren.

Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 a.m., Friday, June 17, 2011, at the United Protestant Church, 130 W. Second Avenue, in Mansfield.
